WILL VAWTER was born on April 13, 1871. He moved with his family to Greenfield, Indiana, at age six. Young Will loved to draw and would frequently fill the pages of his schoolbooks with sketches. Basically a self-taught artist, Vawter started doing illustrations for the *Indianapolis Sentinel* in 1891. Soon his work appeared in other newspapers and magazines.

Around the same time, another Greenfield native was also making a name for himself as a poet. James Whitcomb Riley, known as the "Hoosier Poet," was a national bestseller with poems such as "Little Orphant Annie" and "The Raggedy Man." In 1893, Riley hired Will Vawter as an illustrator. Over the next thirty years, Vawter's work appeared in many of Riley's books.



In 1908, Vawter moved from Greenfield to Nashville, Indiana. There he helped establish what would later be known as the Brown County Art Colony along with other famous Indiana artists. Despite moving to Brown County, Vawter maintained his Greenfield ties. Will Vawter died in 1941 and was laid to rest in Greenfield's Park Cemetery.

Meet Our Juror Kjell Wangensteen

Dr. Kjell Wangensteen is Associate Curator of European Art at the Indianapolis Museum of Art at Newfields. His primary passion is connecting people with



works of art and with new ideas.

He has recently been exploring cross-disciplinary ways to make art from all times and places relevant to new and diverse audiences.

Wangensteen was the 2014-15 Theodore Rousseau Fellow in the department of European paintings at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. He has held positions in the paintings department of the J. Paul Getty Museum, the department of Old Master drawings at the National Gallery of Art, and the department of prints and drawings at the Princeton University Art Museum.

ELIGIBILITY

Artists residing in Indiana are invited to compete in this juried art show.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

All entries must be original work. An image that is copied or done under the guidance of an instructor is not eligible. We accept only framed work or fully painted gallery wrap hung with wire (no saw-tooth hangers), work that has been completed within the last three years, and work that has never been entered in this show before. No more than two entries per artist.

Please include the sale price of your work. ALL ENTRIES **MUST BE FOR SALE** and will be offered at your designated price throughout the exhibit.

All artwork must be clearly labeled with the medium, artist's name, address, phone number and name of work, if applicable. Please include your biographical information for the "Artist Notebook."

After the artwork is judged, artists will be notified by email from hancockcountyarts@gmail.com.

ART MEDIA

Oil & acrylic, watercolor, and everything else 2D. No photos, computer images, or posthumous artwork.
